1. Basic Course Workshop in Medical Education Technologies

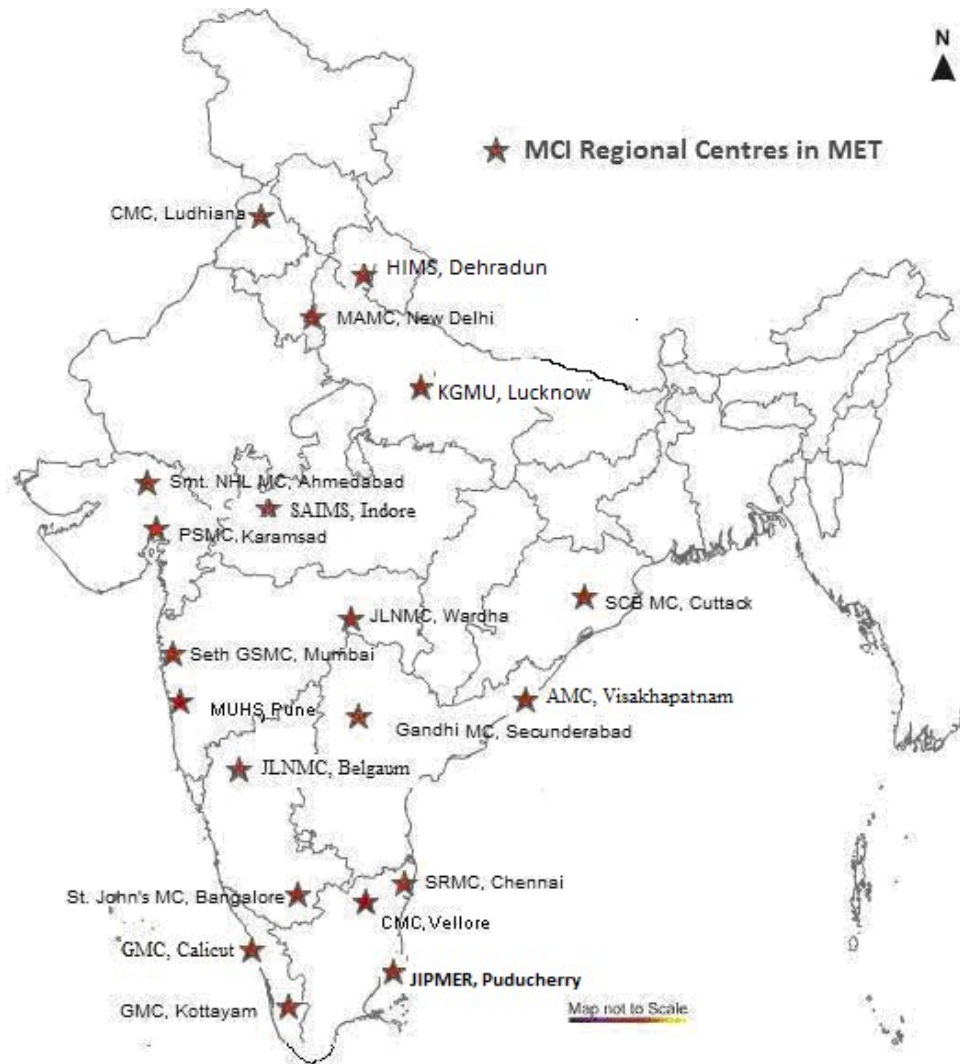
The Medical Council of India, by the MCI Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997, made it mandatory for all medical colleges to establish Medical Education Units (MEUs) or departments in order to enable faculty members to avail modern education technology for teaching. In order to boost this activity, MCI has been conducting Basic Course Workshops in Medical Education Technologies through selected Regional Centres, since July 2009.
